These directions provide a circular Great Missenden walk. To be used in conjunction with the Great Missenden to Amersham walk in Time Out Country Walks near London volume 1 (CW 1) and the Chesham to Great Missenden walk described in Country Walks near London – Volume 2 (CW 2).

Start and finish: Great Missenden station

Length: 16km (10 miles).

Time: 5 hours. For the whole outing, including trains, sights and meals, allow at least 8 hours 30 minutes.

Transport: Trains run between London Marylebone and Great Missenden twice an hour. (Hourly on Sundays.) Journey time is 45 minutes.

OS Landranger Map: 165

OS Explorer Map: 181

Great Missenden, map reference SP 893013, is in **Buckinghamshire**, 15km south east of Aylesbury.

Toughness: 3 out of 10

Walk options: You may combine these directions with the Chesham circular walk directions (4b) for a 12km (7.5 mile) Great Missenden to Chesham walk. Use the Great Missenden to Amersham (CW 1) walk directions until [3], then these directions (4c) then the Chesham circular walk directions (4b).

Saturday Walkers' Club: Take the train nearest to **9.50 am** (before or after) from Marylebone.

WALK DIRECTIONS

Use the Great Missenden to Amersham walk directions until [3] and then follow the directions below.

With Rowan Farm opposite, *turn left along the lane*, your direction 30 degrees. After 400 metres at a T-junction with Chesham Road, cross over to go over a stile into a field, and continue ahead aiming for a stile in the fence on the far side, your direction 350 degrees. In 100 metres go over the stile into the next field. Veer slightly left aiming for the left-hand corner of the field. After 180 metres, cross over a stile (to the right of a metal fieldgate) to go up the right hand side of the next field, your direction 320 degrees. After 150 metres cross over a stile in the right hand corner of the field to go along a fenced in footpath, your direction north. After 160 metres *turn right along a lane*, your direction 80 degrees.

In 100 metres turn left to go through a wooden gate to the left of a wooden fieldgate to go along a fenced in footpath *through a lightly wooded area*, your direction 10 degrees. *After 90 metres at the edge of a wood* (marked by a wooden footpath post on your left-hand side). *Turn right* along a not too clearly defined footpath *along the right hand side of the wood*, your direction 80 degrees.

After 250 metres at the right hand corner of the wood, follow the footpath out of the wood to the right of a redundant kissing gate and *continue in the same direction along a car wide track across a field*, your direction east. After 150 metres the car wide track joins a fence on your left-hand side. After 140 metres go through a wooden kissing gate to the right of a metal fieldgate into the next field to continue along its left-hand side.

After 200 metres at the left-hand field corner go through a wooden gate to *turn left along a lane*. In 180 metres you pass by the entrance to Redding's Farm on your left. After a further 30 metres *turn right to enter a wood, through a metal-chained squeezegate* marked by a metal public footpath signpost, your initial direction 30 degrees. Continue down through the wood. In 200 metres *leave the wood via another metal-chained squeezegate*.

Great Missenden circular walk: You now use the Chesham to Great Missenden walk directions from [4].

Great Missenden to Chesham walk: You now use the 4b Chesham circular walk directions.
